## What Goes Where?

Material must be at the curb by 7AM on your collection day. Pick up times may vary so don't miss the truck!





Excess material must be in a clear bag placed beside the green bin.



All food scraps



Meat/fish bones, shellfish



Coffee grounds, filters, tea bags



Paper towels, tissues, muffin liners, paper plates, pizza boxes



Diaper/adult briefs, feminine hygiene products



Pet waste, kitty litter, fur, animal bedding



Shredded paper

#### **Blue Box Recycling**

Items must be empty, clean and loose. Do not bag.



**Plastics** 



Aluminum cans, tins, foil



Glass jars, bottles



Paper, boxboard, cartons



Cardboard (Flattened and bundled 2'x2'x1')

#### Yard Material

- · Collected April to December
- · Same day as clear bag garbage
- · Branches/twigs must be bundled

No grass clippings, soil or sod



#### Clear Bag Garbage

CLEAR BAGS ONLY.

NO dark, white, or blue bags.



Coffee cups, lids



Wooden/bamboo cutlery, stir sticks



Disposable furnace filters



Broken glass



Padded mailers, bubble wrap

#### **Bulky Items**

- Same day as clear bag garbage
- Max. 3 items



Items in good condition should always be donated to a local charity.

Pour or wipe it into your kitchen catcher.







Keep away from heat




