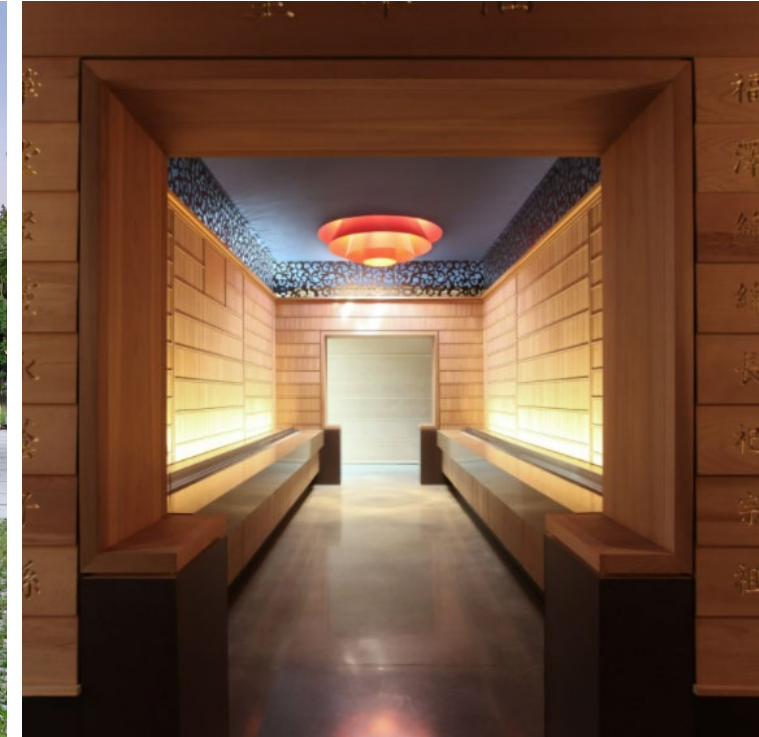

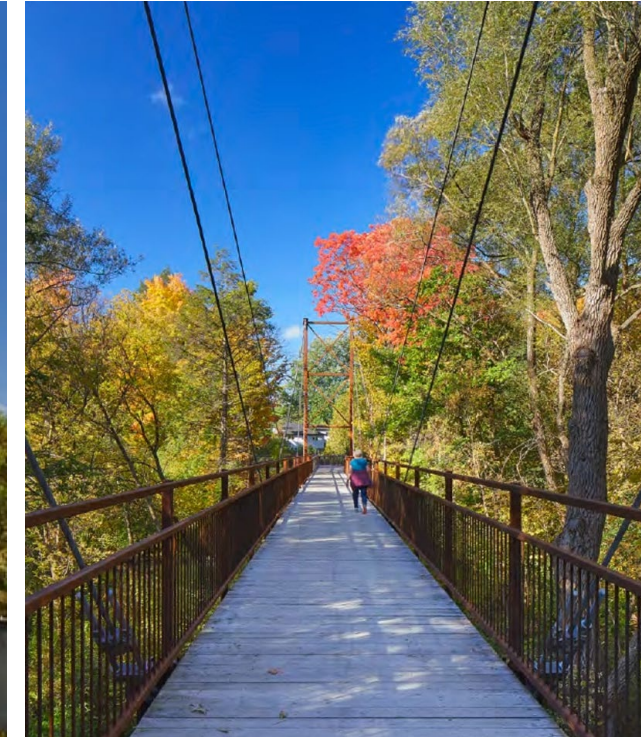

The Milne Creek and Milne Dam Cable-Stayed bridges received a total of 169 votes on Your Voice Markham, winning the People's Choice Award. With a span of 58 metres and 142 metres, respectively, the bridges were designed to minimize disturbance to the natural environment while providing an experience of the valley landscape. They are iconic features of the Markham Rouge Valley Trail that connect neighbourhoods within Markham.
